**9.0 Presentation of Memo No. PLM 014, 2025 - Plateau State Business  
Enabling Reform Action Plan (BERAP), January–December, 2026**

**9.1 The Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Finance in her presentation of  
the Business Enabling Reform Action Plan (BERAP), reminded  
Council of the fact that the Plateau State Government was  
implementing the State Action on Business Enabling Reform  
(SABER) Program, a 3-year initiative of the Federal Government  
through the Federal Ministry of Finance and the Presidential  
Enabling Business Environment Council (PEBEC), in collaboration  
with the World Bank. The aim would be to incentivize and  
strengthen the implementation of business-enabling reforms across  
Nigeria with emphasis on the private sector development which  
remains the major vehicle to create more jobs, increase revenues to  
states and improve social and economic outcomes for citizens.**

**9.1.1 One of the other Eligibility Criteria (EC) to qualify the State to  
participate in the 2026 SABER Program for Results (PforR) is the  
need for Council to consider and approve the 2026 Plateau State  
Business Enabling Reform Action Plan (BERAP).**

**9.1.2 The 2026 State Business Enabling Reform Action Plan (BERAP) was  
prepared in consultation with relevant stakeholders through a 1-  
day workshop, attended by more than 40 participants, including  
representatives from government agencies, development partners,  
community leaders, private sector stakeholders, and other key  
actors, where constructive discussions aimed at evaluating the  
current business environment, identifying bottlenecks, and  
proposing actionable solutions to address these issues were carried  
out.**

**9.1.3 The 2026 BERAP contains reform initiatives, programs and projects across over 15 MDAs with attendant financial implications that when executed, will have a positive impact on the business environment in the State.**

**9.2 The Hon. Commissioner thereafter requested Council to:**

**A. Note**

i. **That the 2026 Business Enabling Reform Action Plan (BERAP) is one of the Eligibility Criteria that will qualify the State to participate in the 2026 SABER Program for results (P for R).**

ii. **The deadline for its upload on the Plateau State Official Website must be on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025.**

**B. Approve and Direct:**

**The 2026 BERAP and direct the Plateau State Information and Communication Technology and Development Agency (PICTDA) to upload the same on the State's Official Website ahead of the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025 deadline.**

**9.3 Council having considered and deliberated extensively on the submission, approved the 2026 State Business Enabling Reform Action Plan (BERAP) and directed the Plateau State Information and Communication Technology and Development Agency (PICTDA) to upload same on the State's Website ahead of the December 31, 2025 deadline via a motion moved by Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Lands, Survey & Town Planning and seconded by Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Education.**
