**10.0 Presentation of Memo No. PLM 015, 2025 - State Action on
Business Enabling Reform(SABER)**

**10.1 The Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Finance who presented the
State Action Enabling (SABER), informed Council that the Program
was a 3-year initiative of the Federal Government through the
Federal Ministry of Finance and the Presidential Enabling Business
Environment Council (PEBEC), in collaboration with the World Bank
to incentivize and strengthen the implementation of business-
enabling reforms across Nigeria with emphasis on the private sector
development which remains the major vehicle to create more jobs,
increase revenues to states and improve social and economic
outcomes for citizens.**

**10.1.1 The Disbursement Linked Indicator 3 (DLI 3) of the SABER
programme is one among other DLIs required to qualify the State
to participate in the 2026 SABER Program for Results (PforR).
SABER DLI 3 focuses on improvement in Public-Private Partnership.**

**10.1.2 The Implementation of the Project Facilitation Fund Business Plan,
Rules, Governance, and Operational Manual is critical to the
success of this DLI and will significantly enhance Plateau State's
investment climate.**

**10.2 In view of the above, Council was requested to:
A. Consider and Approve:
i. the implementation of the Project Facilitation Fund
Business Plan and Operation Manual;**

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- ii. the implementation of the PFF as a State policy Instrument to facilitate business enabling reforms; and**
- B. Direct:**
 - i. All relevant Ministries, Departments and Agencies to support the operationalisation of the fund in line with the approved guidelines;**
 - ii. The Plateau State Information and Communication Technology and Development Agency (PICTDA) to upload the same on the State's official Website.**

10.3 Council, after extensive deliberations, approved the request at paragraph 10.2(I) and (ii) in a motion moved by Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Budget & Economic Planning and seconded by Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Science and Technology.
