








Stronger Digital Foundation



The 1.12% allocation (5.6 billion Naira) aims to improve the primary health care system in Plateau State by; renovating and equipping existing health facilities, recruiting and training additional health care personnel, procuring essential medical equipment and supplies, implementing health education and awareness programs, strengthening the referral system to ensure seamless transfer of patients to secondary facilities.






The 1.10% allocation (5.5 billion Naira) aims to improve the Basic Education system in Plateau State by; improve learning environments and increase access to education, teacher shortages and improve teacher quality, enhance the quality of education by providing necessary resources, implement Inclusive Education Programs, promote access to education for marginalized groups, improve education management and administration to enhance the overall quality of education. By addressing these needs and objectives, the allocated funds intend to improve the quality of Basic Education in Plateau State, increase access to education, and enhance the overall learning experience for students.
